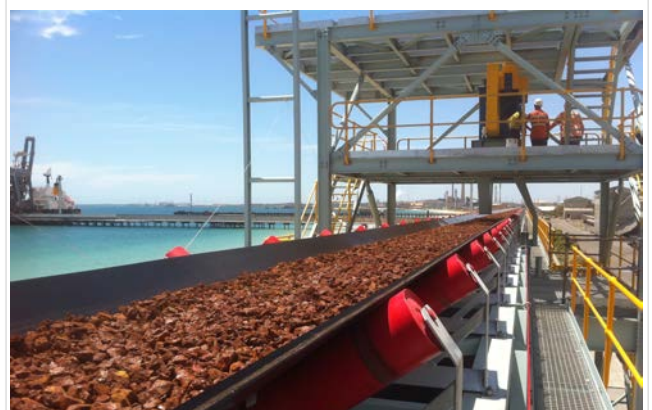
SEPTEMBER REVIEW

Commissioning of the second shiploader is due to start at the beginning of October, with SG Controls again providing an extensive electrical commissioning team.

As commissioning activities continue in the Port Hedland area, a team of HV electricians from SG Controls will mobilise to site this month to conduct VLF and Injection testing.



NAMMULDI
